

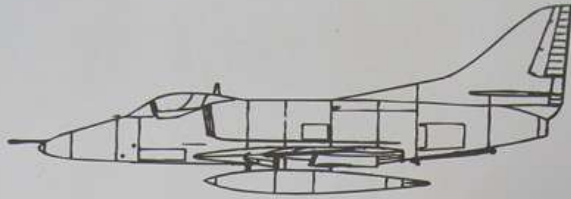

A-4 SKYHAWK



THE A-4 *SKYHAWK* SERIES WAS THE BACKBONE OF NAVY AND MARINE CORPS LIGHT JET ATTACK FORCES FROM THE LATE 1950s INTO THE 1980s. DEVELOPMENT OF THE *SKYHAWK* SERIES CONTINUED DURING THESE YEARS AND INCLUDED MANY IMPROVEMENTS, UPDATES AND ADVANCEMENTS ADDING TO THE A-4S VERSATILITY, PERFORMANCE AND EASE OF MAINTENANCE. TOTAL *SKYHAWK* PRODUCTION REACHED ALMOST 3,000.

THE A-4 TYPE AIRCRAFT WAS FLOWN BY THE NAVY FLIGHT DEMONSTRATION SQUADRON, *BLUE ANGELS* FROM 1974 TO 1986.
